The M.O. Campbell Center is located in Aldine ISD, between I-45 and Highway 59, south of Beltway 8 in north Houston. From downtown, take the Aldine-Westfield exit off Beltway 8. Turn south on Aldine-Westfield and then turn west on Aldine Bender Road.

### What do you need to participate?

- Bring multiple copies of your résumé, transcript(s), and teaching certificate(s). If you do not have teaching experience, an evaluation from your student teaching will be helpful.
- The \$10.00 attendance fee collected at the door (cash only) covers both days. Child care facilities will not be available at the job fair site.
- If enrolled in an alternative certification program, bring verification of enrollment.

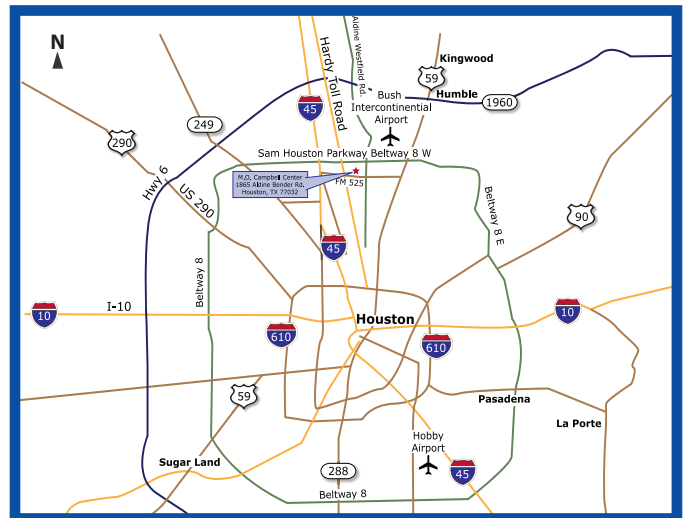
